

News from the SIRAS project: Medical Bill EDI Information Session

The Medical Bill Reporting Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) is one of the three main deliverables for the Self-Insurance Risk Analysis System (SIRAS) project. (The other two parts of SIRAS are a customer service portal and a risk analytic system.)

In our last communication, we let you know that the technical requirements for our Medical Bill EDI <u>are now available through ISO</u>, our third-party vendor.

Online Information Session

On Tuesday, July 19, we will offer an information session about the EDI. Labor & Industries will be hosting the session in conjunction with ISO. The session will help self-insured employers (or the entity submitting data on their behalf) to understand and interpret the technical requirements. Those who are not familiar with the IAIABC standard or data reporting through an EDI are encouraged to participate.

Implementation schedule

We are planning to have the Medical Bill EDI system in place and ready for early testing in late 2016 and voluntary reporting in early 2017. However, mandatory reporting will not begin until July 2017.
